



What is Wildfire?

Wildfire is NOT another student leadership team. Traditional student leadership teams tie a student's leadership ability and progress to attendance. We understand that a student is juggling many things during their high school career: academics, sports, and hobbies.

Therefore, we see the Wildfire team as simply a tool to stoke the fire of their faith. The goal of this team is to propel students to the next stage in their walk with Christ through various methods including teaching, video curriculum, camping trips, intentional times of development, group projects, and optional personal studies. Everyone is invited to participate regardless of where they are at in their journey with Christ.

What will I be doing?

Wildfire Wednesday Meetings (5pm-6:30pm): What should a student expect to experience at a typical meeting? Each meeting will start with a \$5 dinner (we post every week what dinner will be), announcements, some kind of group mixer/activity, and a video bible study. Throughout the various semesters, we will take time to prepare for group projects, special events, "Wildfire runs the weekend," and the "Wildfire House Party."

*Summer Semester: During the Summer, Wildfire meets weekly on Wednesdays. In addition to the weekly meetings, we will also plan several fun "outings" in order to focus on building community and fellowship. Those "outings" include bbq's, pool parties, Boomer's, camping trips, bowling, & more.

*Fall Semester: During the Fall, Wildfire meets twice a month (2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month). Students will also be assigned a group project on a specific book of the bible. This project requires one short typed report from the whole group, and an individual art element that represents what they have learned from the book.

*Spring Semester: During the Spring, Wildfire meets twice a month (2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month). During this semester students will take everything they have learned from previous semesters and apply it to their final group project: designing and orchestrating a social cause that will benefit a specific need in the world.

Expectations for Wildfire Team Members:

1. Committed to pursuing a relationship with God in which you are growing and constantly developing, with an understanding that God has control of the steering wheel of your life.
2. Reflect a Christ-like attitude in decisions and lifestyle.
3. Be willing to contribute to the community of believers that gather at Wildfire, whether in group settings or one-on-one.
4. Consistent in attending and participating IN THE majority of FUEL events (camps, weekend services, FUEL groups, and community events).
5. Faithful in being at all Wildfire meetings, retreats, and events (and communicating when you are unable to).
6. Intentional about being a positive and encouraging person toward their family, friends, community and church body. This includes interactions in Cyberspace and Social Media.
7. Must complete all Wildfire assignments (individual and group) with the appropriate level of effort.
8. Must have the full support and acknowledgement of your parents concerning your involvement in the Wildfire program, meetings and events.
